IATVHSS Rd 3: Montezuma, June 7, 2009

Results: **Luke**—7th of 10, AA/Pro; 12th/71 Overall
Al—1st of 3, +50



Highlights/Comments:

Very muddy race for Al in the morning session—he finished the race unlike many of his competitors though and although the morning overalls were never posted, he did finish well into the top half. The track did dry up for the afternoon session but Luke had a rough start. Running in the top 4 on lap one, he took a turn a little too wide and was ejected from his quad which went rolling down the trail, bending his steering stem. This made for a tough race as he had to fight his way through some of the other amateur classes, but he did manage to finish the race.
